# Today in the Ausseerland

#### **Boulderbox Bad Mitterndorf**



Bouldering is climbing without a rope and harness on boulders, rock faces or in the climbing gym at jump height. There are six abseiling points in the climbing box, which are color-coded with several routes.

In the bouldering area, there are several routes of varying difficulty, from threes to tens. There is also a campus board for ambitious climbers to optimize their finger strength.

Don't worry, there is a 30 centimeter thick mat on the floor for safety.

#### Gößl & village church Gößl



The village church in Gößl, also known as Raphael Church, is a special gem in Ausseerland. It was built between 1819 and 1820 by 14 Gößl families who wanted to save themselves the arduous journey to Bad Aussee for mass. The church was built at their own expense and on their own land, which makes it a rare example of a privately built and preserved church to this day. Today, the church not only serves as a place for church services and events, but also as a symbol of the sense of community and the initiative of the people of Gößl

#### Lake Altaussee



The water is crystal clear and transparent and has a slightly dark blue color. This is why Lake Altaussee is also known as the "dark blue inkwell". The view of the Dachstein, but also the different perspectives of the Loser, Trisselwand, Tressenstein and Sandling will inspire you. A seven-kilometre gravel panoramic trail leads around the lake. The path is ideal for walks, leisurely hikes and short breaks by the water - if you want to take a shortcut or get to the Seewiese in comfort, you can use the solar-powered boat.

#### Sagtümpel - Tauplitz



The legendary Sagtümpel - one of Austria's rare Vauclusian giant karst springs-lies idyllically in the forest to the north-east of Tauplitz. The water rises from a deep spring lake from the bottom to the top and impresses with its changing flow and natural power. The spring used to be used to supply drinking water, but was renaturalized in 2017. Today, the Sagtümpel is a popular excursion destination and the 30 m high Tauplitz waterfall plunges into the Grimmingbach nearby - another natural highlight in the region.

# Spring in Ausseerland

#### Loser Panoramastraße

The Loser Panoramastraße in Altaussee is a 9 km long toll mountain road with magnificent views of the Ausseerland region. It leads up to 1,600 m above sea level and is also popular with cyclists and e-bikers. #### Tauplitzalm Alpine Road

The Tauplitzalm Alpine Road is a 10 km long toll mountain road from Bad Mitterndorf to 1,600 m above sea level, which impresses with magnificent views of the Ausseerland region.
