## Spring in Ausseerland

### Loser Panoramastraße

The Loser Panoramastraße in Altaussee is a 9 km long toll mountain road with magnificent views of the Ausseerland region. It leads up to 1,600 m above sea level and is also popular with cyclists and e-bikers. It is only accessible by car outside the operating hours of the Loser Panoramabahn.

### Tauplitzalm Alpine Road

The Tauplitzalm Alpine Road is a 10 km long toll mountain road from Bad Mitterndorf to 1,600 m above sea level, which impresses with magnificent views of the Ausseerland region. The Tauplitzalm is Europe's highest lake plateau and a popular excursion destination at any time of year.
